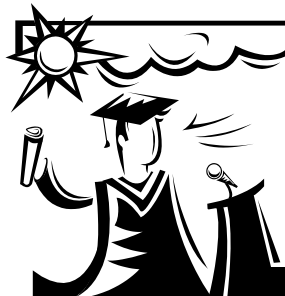
CLASS OF 2012 SENIOR PROM – MAY 5

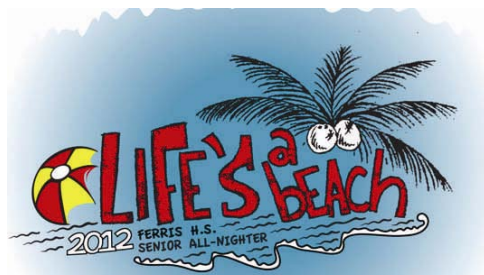

SCHOLARSHIPS – OLD AND NEW

- **Hillel Foundation for Jewish Life at the University of Washington**
For Jewish students with financial need who plan to attend the University of Washington. **Deadline: April 28.**
- **Gerald Hester Educational Studies Scholarship:**
Two scholarships of up to \$1,000 will be awarded to seniors enrolled in Spokane Public Schools who plan to pursue a career in elementary or secondary education. Application in the College Career Center. **Deadline: April 29.**
- **Katy Reeves Performing Arts Scholarship**
For a senior who plans to pursue dance, music or theatre at a college or university. The scholarship awards are \$1,000 and \$750. **April 29.**
- **Gerald L. Saling Memorial Rotary Scholarship**
Must have a 3.0 gpa or higher and be a resident of Spokane County. Two \$1,500 scholarships will be awarded. **April 30.**
- **Inland Empire Hall of Fame**
This organization will offer a \$1,000 scholarship to a senior girl who participates in high school fast pitch softball. Should have a strong résumé and be a good student. **May 1.**
- **2012 Northwest Foundation for Maxillofacial Research and Education**
This is a wonderful local scholarship. We have had recipients in the past. The applicant must plan to enroll in medical, nursing or dental education programs. There is a proposed budget requirement, but this scholarship is not based on need. **May 1.**
- **Gilda's Club's 7th Annual IT'S ALWAYS SOMETHING Teen Writing Contest**
Win cash prizes! The "It's Always Something" Writing Contest invites students to share their stories about cancer in personal essays of 500 to 2,000 words. Cash prizes are awarded to the top essays. **May 1.**
- **Jarvis Memorial Scholarship**
A wonderful local scholarship. Last year they awarded (2) \$1,000 scholarships to seniors who are active members of an organized bowling club. **May 1.**
- **Hamblen Elementary John Maher Scholarship**
Applicant should have a strong academic record and résumé. Must have attended Hamblen Elementary for 4th – 6th grades. **May 3.**
- **Panhandle State Bank**
The award is for \$1,000. Criteria: 2.5 gpa or higher; must be of good standing in school and community. Requires community service. The scholarship does not require the applicant to be a member of the bank. Return applications to Mrs. Vincent. **May 6.**
- **Spokane South Rotary Ron Biondi Memorial Scholarships:**
Two scholarships, in the amount of \$2,000 each will be awarded to Ferris seniors. Applicant must have a 3.2 minimum gpa, strong participation in a wide range of services – community service, leadership, school activities. Ferris will select five applicants to be interviewed by the South Rotary Club. Application in the College Career Center. **Deadline: May 7**
- **Adams Elementary – Brent Streich Memorial Scholarship**
The award is for \$500 and eligible seniors needed to attend Adams for at least 2 years. Applicant should have community service and school activities. **May 11.**
- **Jefferson Elementary PTG Scholarship**
Jefferson is awarding \$500 to a senior who attended Jefferson Elementary 4th – 6th grades. **May 11.**
- **Silme Domingo & Gene Viernes Scholarship in Labor Studies at the University of Washington**
The scholarship is awarded to seniors entering into the UDUB who are committed to the principles of justice and equality and have demonstrated financial need. **May 18.**
A \$500 scholarship to a senior who attended Wilson Elementary. One of the questions they ask is "have you stayed connected to the Wilson Community?" That gives you some idea of what they're looking for. **May 28.**
