The 2011/2012 year has started off with two new staff members:

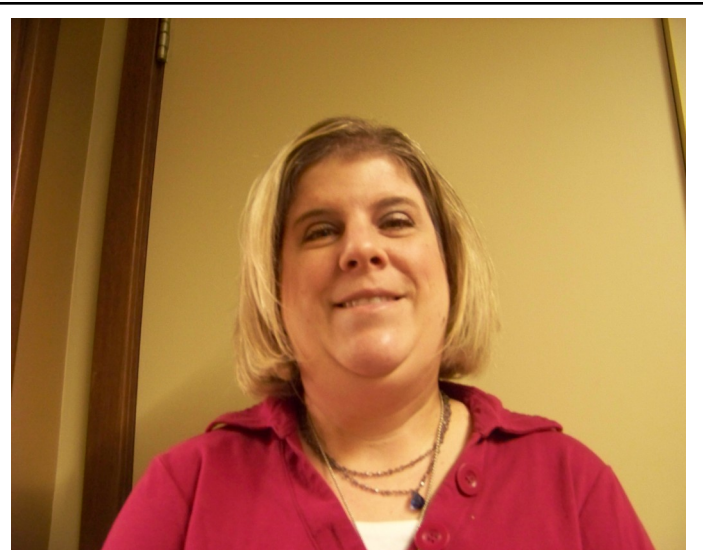
Laura Lloyd is our new office secretary!
