## Logan Basketball Teams Hoop it Up!

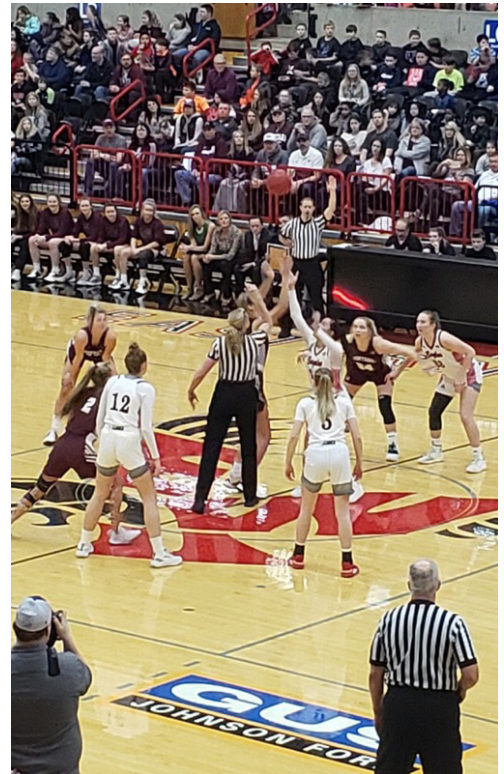
5th and 6th grade girls and boys have been enjoying the basketball season in true Hoopfest 3-on-3 style. Take in some of the highlights!
