Good day to each of you,

As students continue to attend school virtually, I wanted to share a few tips for helping your scholar find success in an online learning world while allowing your family to retain its privacy and sanity.

• Location: Find a location at home that sees your lion sitting in a location with a wall directly behind them. This will help ensure that your scholar's classmates do not see what is happening in the home behind the online learner.

• Microphone: Remind your scholar to keep their mic off unless they are actively sharing with the class or teacher. This helps keep background noise out of the class session and ensures other online learners are not privy to the discussions that other members of your household are having.

• Headphones: Consider having your scholar use a pair of headphones while in class. This will help your young lion concentrate and keep your home a little quieter. This is especially true if you have more than one child learning online at the same time. Logan has many pairs of headphones that were donated that can be given to families for free. Contact the office if you need a pair or two.

I continue to appreciate all that Logan families and teachers are doing to make the most of these challenging learning times. We look forward to having more and more students here learning in person and will do whatever it takes to help those who continue learning at home find the success that they deserve.

Crossing Guards and Noon Supervisors Needed!

Logan is in need of permanent hires and substitutes to serve as morning and afternoon crossing guards, as well as supervisors for the lunchroom and playground during the noon hour. Most regular employees get hired on after first starting as a substitute, and rarely do they have to work very long before being hired on a more permanent basis. The wage for these positions is \$13.50 per hour. And while a background and fingerprint check is required for employment with Spokane Public Schools, Logan will pay the associated fees for anyone after 10 hours of service. It is a great way to get outdoors, interact with

students and become more involved in the school that your

In order to meet family requests and have enough time and product to make thousands of 5-day kits, some changes to available pick up times have been made. Please note the changes below:


- Mondays from 11:50 a.m.-12:50 p.m (same lunch time as before but no Monday evening time)
- Tuesdays from 5-6 p.m. (new day)
- Wednesdays from 11:50 a.m.-12:30 p.m. (Same day, new closing time)

Mobile Meals Start Oct. 6

To help families who are unable to pick up meal kits at a school, we will be offering mobile meals delivery on Tuesdays, starting Oct. 6. Drop-offs are scheduled between 3:30-4:45 p.m.

If you are able to pick up your meal kit at a school, please continue to do so. This service is intended to support those families with barriers to accessing meal pickup at schools. And remember, if you can pick up at school, you will also be able to pick up dinner as part of Logan's Tuesday Family Meal, and boxes of groceries from the 2nd Harvest Food Distribution.
