Our funding is based on our free/reduced meal numbers. I encourage all Logan families to check their eligibility by completing an online meal application to be processed by October 15th 2021.

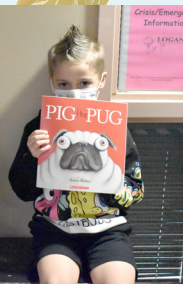
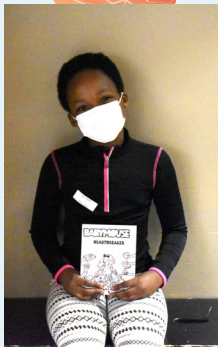
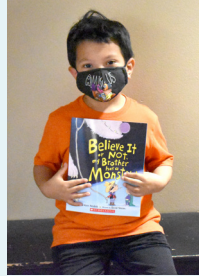
