- If you have completed the above, start looking through your Post-Secondary Launch book to see what next steps are for your plan after high school.



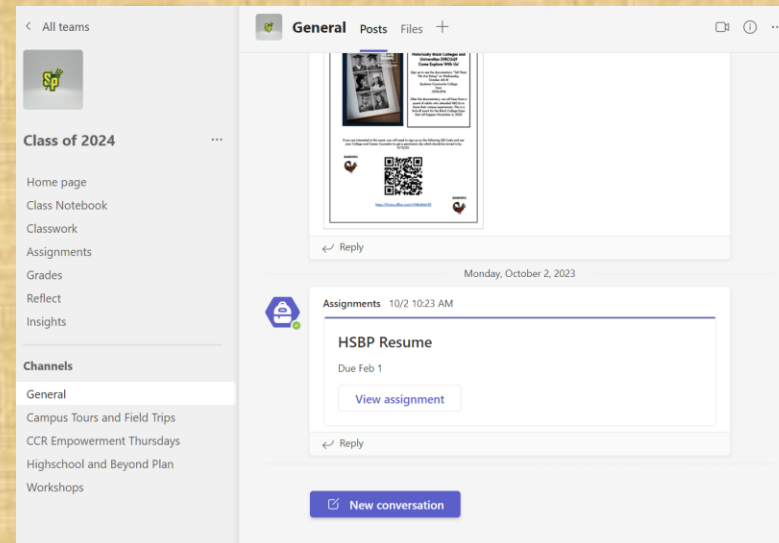
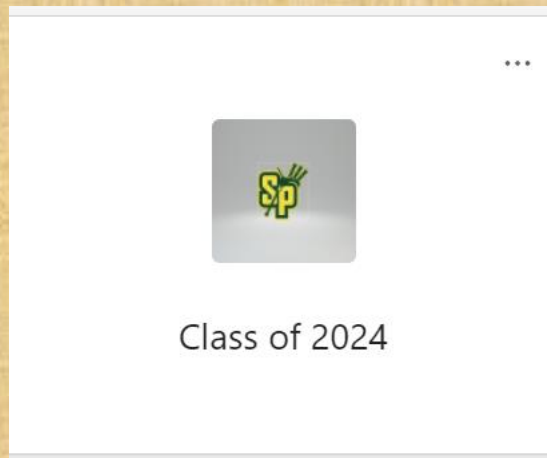

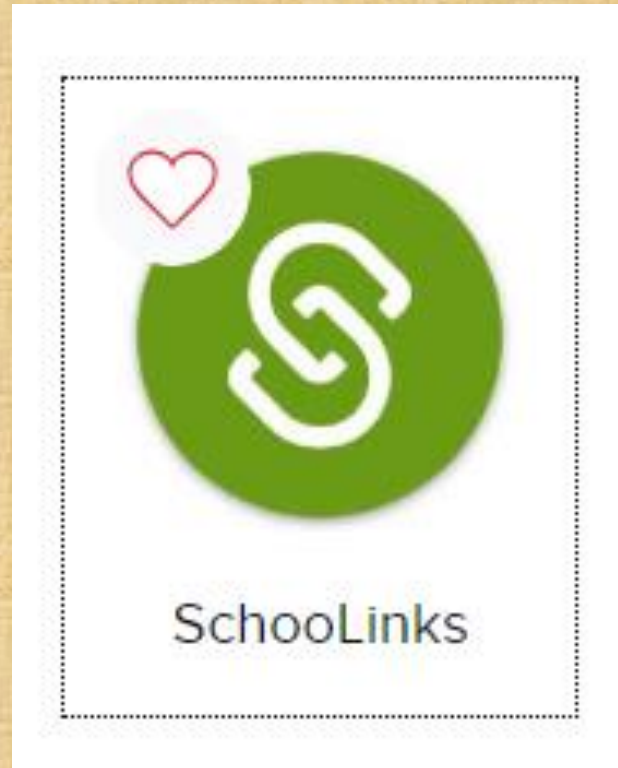

Once you are in Schoolinks:

If you **HAVE NEVER** logged in before, you will complete the 'onboarding.' This is an interest inventory, complete each question. Your screen will look like this:

If you're not sure what to choose, don't worry.

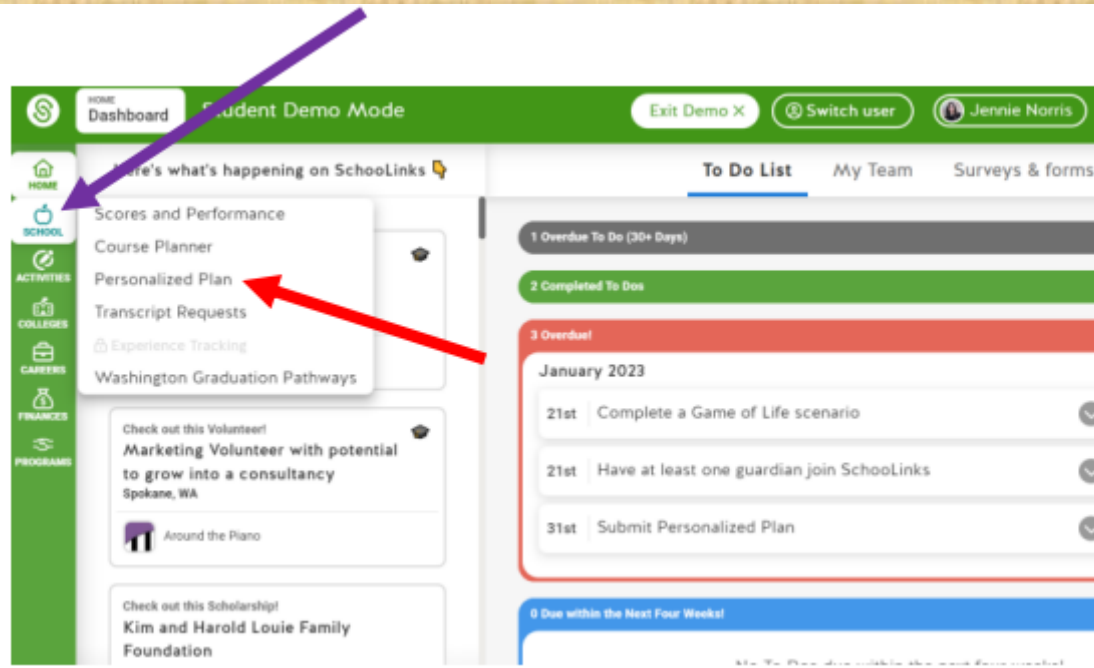

Once you are in Schoolinks:

If you **HAVE** logged in before, even if it was in middle school you will need to find the 'apple icon on the left side menu.

Then click on **Personalized Plan**.



Step 1: Log into Schoolinks through Clever.

Step 2: Once you are in Schoolinks, click on the Apple Logo titled "School" on the left-hand side of your screen (purple arrow)

Step 3: Click on "Personalized Plan" (red arrow)

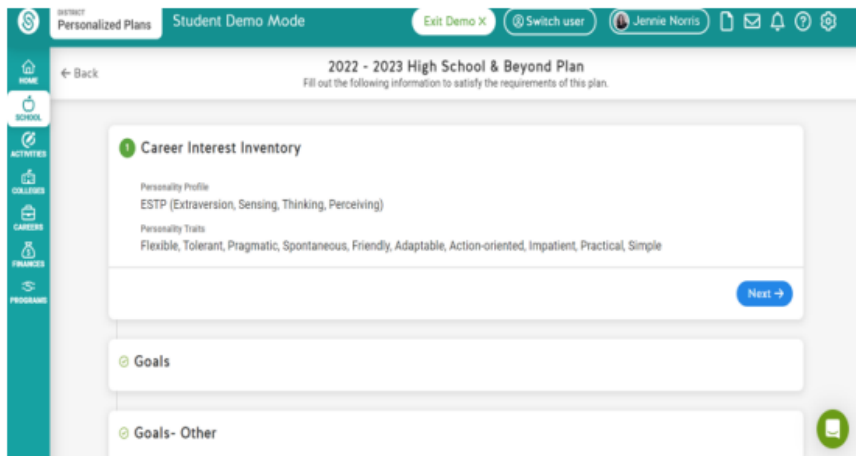


Step 4: After you have completed step 3, your screen will look like the above picture. Select "Start Plan" **(blue arrow)**

2023-2024

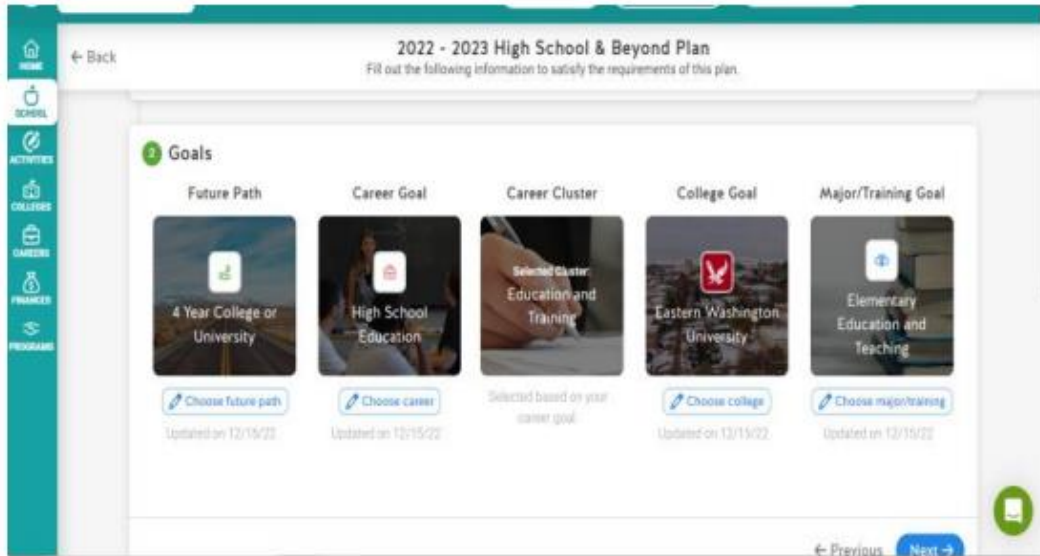
Click on 'Start Plan'

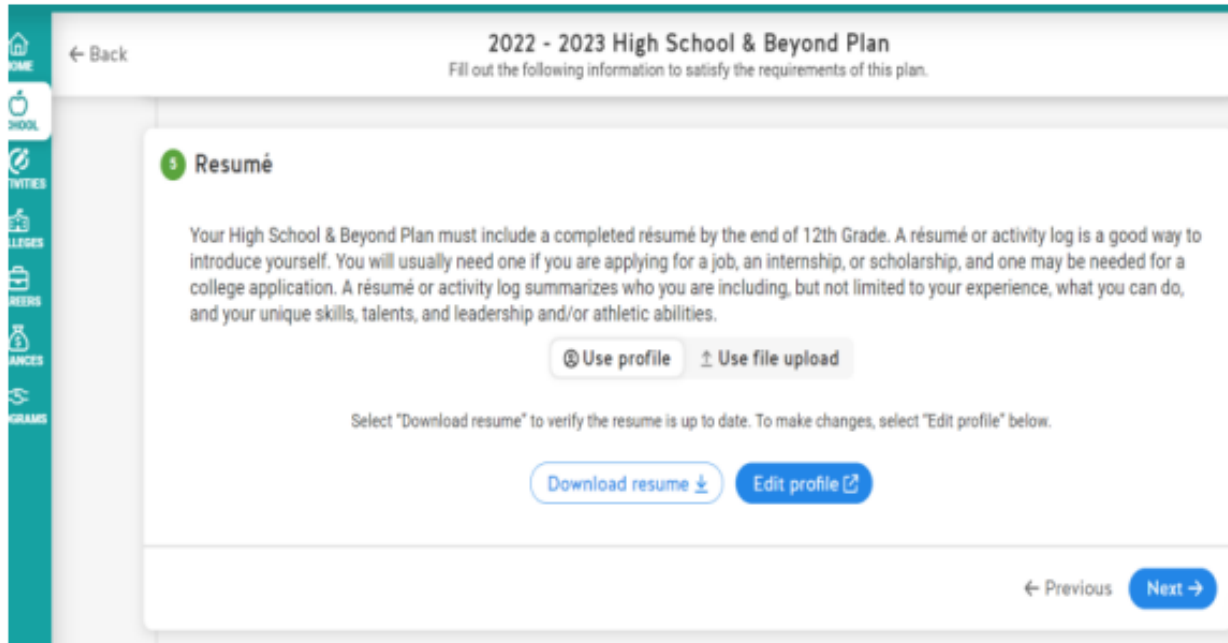
