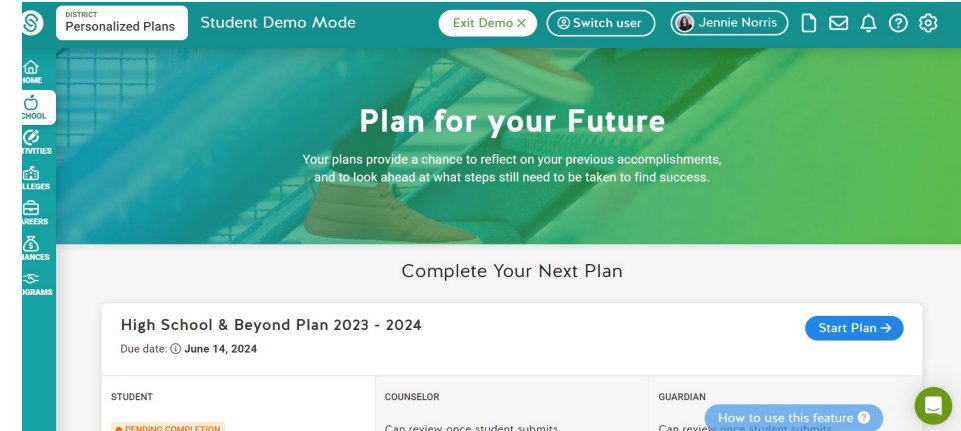

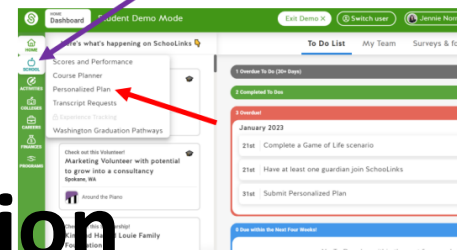

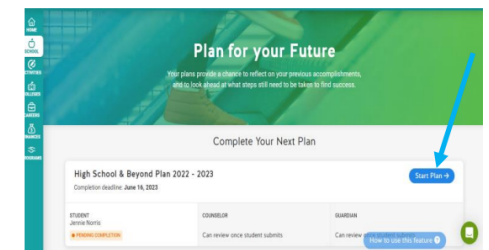
2024 Seniors: HSBP Directions
