

You will complete a HIGH SCHOOL AND BEYOND PLAN that reflects what you would like to do after you leave SP. The general categories are:

4-Year

This means you plan on going straight to a 4-year university. If this is your plan, you will need two consecutive years of a the same world language.

2-year

Two-year degrees will allow you to transfer to a 4-year university. World language is not required and a more financially feasible way to earn your degree.

Professional/Technical

Skilled trades are in demand! Consider New Tech Skills Center your junior and/or senior year. If this plan appeals to you.

Military

Air Force, Navy, Coast Guard, Army, Marines, and Space Force. You can enlist directly or attend school at the same time. Scholarships are available.

Work Force

Start building your resume today!

- ASVAB -
