**You will complete a HIGH SCHOOL AND BEYOND PLAN that reflects what you would like to do after you leave SP. The general categories are:**

## **4-Year**

This means you plan on going straight to a 4-year university. If this is your plan, you will need two consecutive years of a the same world language.

## **2-year**

Two-year degrees will allow you to transfer to a 4-year university. World language is not required and a more financially feasible way to earn your degree.

## **Professional/Technical**

Skilled trades are in demand! Consider New Tech Skills Center your junior and/or senior year. If this plan appeals to you.

## **Military**

Air Force, Navy, Coast Guard, Army, Marines, and Space Force. You can enlist directly or attend school at the same time. Scholarships are available .

## **Work Force**
