AP Biology Summer Assignment 2023

Welcome to AP Biology! I wanted to give you the opportunity to start thinking about Biology over the summer without a large amount of pressure to dive in to the content we will be studying. Some of you will be striving to earn a "5" on the AP test and I would encourage you to look at the Khan Academy AP Bio course if you are wanting to start content early(this is optional but encouraged).

Purpose: For your summer assignment, I want you to start interacting with the natural work, start thinking like a biologist and interact with your peers.

Requirements:

- Post at least once per week(you can post more than this if you would like
- Post about each of the following things over the summer
 - At least 8-10 different plant species
 - At least 3-5 different animal species
 - At least 3-5 different bug species

How to compete this

- 1. Download the following apps on your phone- iNaturalist and Seek by iNaturalist
- 2. Open the iNaturalist and create an account using your personal email address(not your school email)
- 3. You must do this step before moving on: after you have an account, click on "Projects" and search for and join: Mr. Munsey AP Bio Summer Assignment
- 4. Then open the Seek by iNaturalist app and login using your information from the iNaturalist app
- Then watch the following video on youtube: https://youtu.be/gsBnkOX0Lxo or search for "Identify Wildlife with Seek by iNaturalist".
- 6. Start scanning plants and animals around you. They could be anywhere in town or anywhere you travel-Be sure to post to iNaturalist to add it to our project!
