### **PRINCIPAL'S REPORT** (Kristene Gillmer):

April marks the time of year where we want to finish strong and begin looking at starting up again next year. It is a busy balancing act.

Things coming up: Smarter Balance Assessment (3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade) state testing, begins the first week of May; Students take 2 literacy tests and 2 math tests. Trying to impact the building for only 4 days. And kids who miss those dates will be provided with make up days to get all caught up.

While we are using other measures for math and literacy growth (Lexia and Dreambox), that Smarter Balance data is still looked statewide at to talk about how schools are doing around the state. It is noteworthy that Audubon has been "In Improvement" since before K.Gillmer arrived. Last year, improved our standing by having only one student group below the threshold for achievement. Now we have moved out of the "Title 1" threshold and out of all those student groups for achievement. No longer get financial support but we will still get coaching support from other Education Organization around the state. This is a testament to the staff, the teachers, and partnerships, including PTO. The "3-pronged approach" which included bring in family/community engagement, Audubon has relied heavily on PTO for support. The impacts are noticeable throughout the school.

# Looking ahead

Will be getting our staffing for next year. Once that is known and confirmed, KG will share with families. 395 students for now (not including Pre-K)

D.Musser: What is the goal for the student enrollment? KG: about 400. There are elementary schools throughout the district that are well below 300, which can be tricky to fund those schools. A handful that are at 500, and there is an effort to reduce the load on those schools.
