We had a fantastic dance party at recess today!! Your kids have got some good moves :) Have a delightful weekend and enjoy the sunshine!

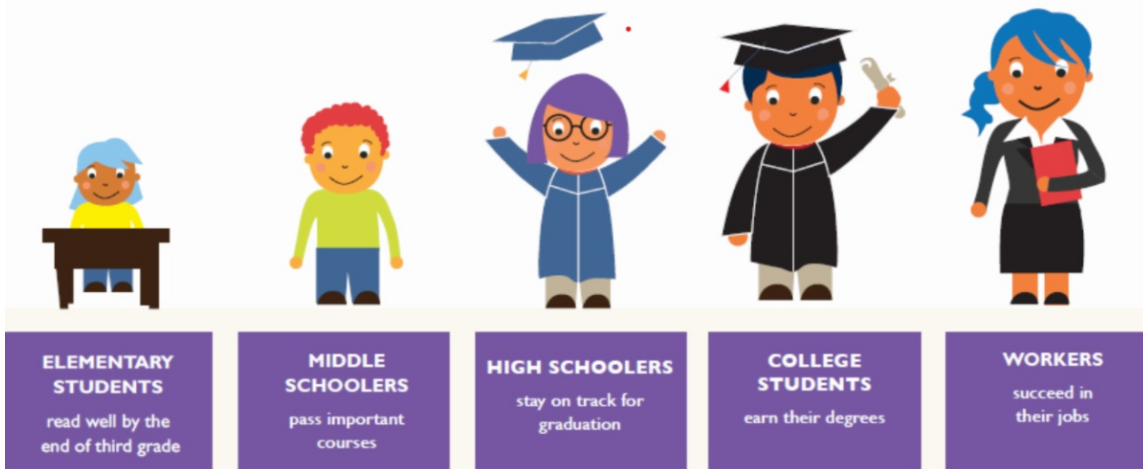
