Playground Closed for One Hour After School Each Day

The Jefferson playground is closed for 60 minutes after school lets out each day. The playground is reserved for after-school activities and for Jefferson's Express Childcare program. Families are asked to remind their scholars that they are



to go straight home after school. Families picking up students are also asked to help by having their children stay off the equipment until after 4nm.
