

Sign up for Launch Conferences!

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Schools across Spokane will be starting the year with a new concept called Launch Conferences. These will replace the traditional parent-teacher conferences that took place after school was well underway and saw scholars released early every day for a week.



Conference times are available between 8am-5:50pm Thursday, September 1 and between 8:00-2:20pm on Friday, September 2. Kindergarten families also have Tuesday, September 6 from 8:00-3:00 as an option, as kindergarten WAKids conferences are longer than a typical conference.

Families of scholars in grades 1-6 will sign up using the district's electronic scheduler *here*. In addition to the conference with the teacher, families are asked to plan an additional 30-45 minutes to be spent visiting various parts of the school and taking care of important tasks that will get everyone off to a smooth start.

Kindergarten families have received a letter from their scholar's teacher indicating the time they have been assigned and steps to take if a different time is needed.

- will receive a welcome email from Peachiar that includes
- a username and password. This is provided to give you •
- the opportunity to manage your account and flier delivery •
 - preferences. You do not need to login to receive or view school digital fliers.
