

PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

Parents and Community Members,

For the past three weeks, we have been exploring a powerful concept known as Mindset. We have learned that individuals with fixed mindsets believe that qualities such as intelligence or talent are innate and unchangeable. You either have it or you do not; you're either smart or you are not. Those with a growth mindset, however, understand that the brain grows through struggle and persistence, much like our muscles grow when working out. Studies show that those with a growth mindset reach higher levels of success than those with fixed mindsets do, in part, because they embrace challenges, not as a reflection of who they are, but as a means to their own fulfillment and understanding.



In the coming weeks, I will be expanding our mindset Journey into the realm of "mathematical mindsets" with another Stanford Researcher, Jo Boaler. With the importance of math success as a lynchpin for future employment at all levels, mathematical mindsets will play an important part in the education of all of Jefferson's children of promise.



Parent-Teacher Conferences (page 15)

In addition to the launch conferences that take place before scholars are in classrooms in the fall, another set of full-day conferences take place in January. The district is no longer doing a conference week with early release days. We will now have two full days for families to meet with teachers (January 26 & 27). This will be an excellent time to discuss a scholar's progress and chart a path for finishing the rest of the year strong.



Many classroom teachers request that students attend the conference as well, and in some cases the student will be involved in leading portions of the conference.


ATTENDANCE MATTERS

Missing a day of school here and there may not seem like much, but absences add up!


