# SIGN UP FOR LAUNCH CONFERENCES!

Schools across Spokane will again kick off the year with Launch Conferences.

Conference times are available throughout the day this Thursday and Friday for scholars in grades 1 through 5. Kindergarten families have received a letter from their scholar's teacher indicating the time they have been assigned and steps to take if a different time is needed.

Families of scholars in grades 1-6 will sign up using the district's electronic scheduler. The schedular can be found at <u>https://</u> weba.spokaneschools.org/conference.

In addition to the conference with the teacher, families are asked to plan an additional 30-45 minutes to spend on a scavenger hunt visiting various parts of the school, looking for the hidden Patriot Puppies and taking care of important tasks that will get everyone off to a smooth start.

#### MORNING ARRIVAL, BREAKFAST AND MORE!

Scholars who are not eating breakfast at school are allowed on campus beginning at 8:15am. They will enter the school directly at that time and through the doors that they exit from in the afternoon. Exit doors will be shared with families during launch conferences this week. Scholars with younger siblings may enter the school through the door of the younger sibling if needed.



Those wishing to eat breakfast may arrive on campus to eat after 8:00am. Breakfast eaters will enter through the doors near the cafeteria on the north side of the school.

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#### Peach Jar Provides Electronic "Backpack" for Families

Jefferson, and all schools in Spokane Public Schools, utilize a free digital service, called Peachjar, to put school and community fliers at



your fingertips. No more lost or forgotten fliers buried in the bottom of a child's backpack.

Peachjar will send information right to your device via a free app. Digital school fliers will come directly into your virtual backpack and remain there until they expire for easy review and reference.

No action is required on your part beyond making sure that Jefferson has your most current email address. You will receive a welcome email from Peachjar that includes a username and password. This is provided to give you the opportunity to manage your account and flier delivery preferences. <u>You do not need to login to receive or view school</u> <u>digital fliers</u>.

To ensure smooth delivery of this communication, we suggest you add "school@peachjar.com" to your email contacts. When you receive your first e-flier, be sure to click "always display images."

This system is used exclusively for distribution of district and school-approved communications. Your email address will not be shared or used for any other purpose. You can also visit Jefferson's website to see school/district-approved digital fliers. Simply click the e-fliers button with the picture of the peach on

Jefferson's homepage.



Note: Peachjar is free to our schools because community partners pay a small service fee to post and distribute their flyers digitally (typically much less than the cost to copy and deliver paper fliers).
