




## PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

In their 2016 report, "Preventing Missed Opportunity: Taking Collective Action to Confront Chronic Absence," Attendance Works noted that "more



than 6.5 million students, or about 13 percent, miss three or more weeks of school which is enough time to erode their achievement and threaten their chance of (later) graduating."


