## COURSE DESCRIPTION

Spanish 1 & 2 is a highly communicative introduction to the language. As a student, you will learn to understand and converse in real life situations using authentic expressions. You will be able to do things like order food, shop, find your way around a foreign city, and make new friends. You will be reading short stories and articles, learning to pronounce the language, and writing everything from postcards to paragraphs.

As you immerse yourself in the culture and customs of the language, you will begin to develop an appreciation of its music, art, foods, and folklore. This course will result in a HS credit. Note: not every high school or middle school offers every world language.
