Approval of 6/18 Minutes- Minutes Approved

**Review current Summer document with SPS Update** (includes information on both Phase 2 and 3 and WIAA updates):

- The current Summer Action Plan was reviewed and updated by Nursing, Safety/Risk Management, Facilities/Maintenance
- Every activity/sport will need to submit an individualized safety plan to SPS
- Participants will need to sign a COVID 19 Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability
- Summer Action Plan is a working document updated weekly

**Will we recommend Summer Activities in Phase 2?**

- SPS is recommending no activities in Phase 2 until further notice- will be reviewed regularly
- We will be working on protocols to allow activities to begin when it is safe to do so and when we have all the required safety protocols in place
- Watch for weekly updates
- Central Valley, East Valley and Mead are not providing summer activities while in Phase 2 of COVID 19

**Next Steps:** Including Summer Communication Plan, Possible Training for Coaches

- All coaches will receive formal training on COVID 19 procedures that include the safety plan, security of student information
- This training must be completed before any summer activity is conducted

- It was suggested that FamilyID be used by coaches to communicate and with families
- FamilyID is not used in all high schools for summer activities
- Every lead bookkeeper has access to FamilyID
- There should be multiple people at each school with access to FamilyID
- We are not providing face masks for summer practices
- Students and athletes must provide their own masks (if students arrive without their own mask one will be provided- families will work with the school to arrange if needed)
- Masks should be cleaned on a daily basis – we have no control of washing masks daily
- In Phase 3 Pullman is using QR codes checking students in- those ideas will be sent to Nursing

**Brainstorm ideas** for what needs to be done for Fall Implementation

- Aaron is going to speak with Providence about providing face masks
- Send workouts for students who can't afford clubs – equity issues
- Concern with what happens in Phase 2 anecdotal
- Could be catastrophic
- Do not rush to Phase 3
- Only 1/10<sup>th</sup> of COVID 19 cases are reported
