Our students have worked diligently all year at learning the Common Core State Standards. They have also been practicing their computer skills by taking practice Interim and IO assessments, so that they are confident taking the online tests! Appropriate School Dress

A student's appearance significantly affects the way others respond to him/her. Attire can be conducive or disruptive to the educational process. Clothing containing references to alcohol, drugs, inappropriate behavior or language, or that is provocative or distracting to others, should not be worn to school.

Also, shirts must cover the shoulders and midriff and no spaghetti straps. Our rule for shorts and skirts is: when standing with hands at sides, the hem of the shorts or skirt must be below the fingertips. No hats, bandanas, scarves, or head wear may be worn inside the school except on special spirit days. Chains or other potentially dangerous attire will not be allowed at school. Health and Fitness is a required part of the curriculum. For your child's safety, please have them wear or bring tennis shoes. Flip flops or back-less sandals are not to be worn to school for safety reasons.


