Welcome to ONE Spokane Stadium, the home field for Spokane Schools, operated by the Spokane Public Facilities District (PFD).

TRAFFIC & PARKING: Spectators driving to ONE Spokane Stadium may utilize the Free parking for SPS events that will be offered north of the Spokane Arena in LOT C. (see parking map) SPS attendees will be required to display the SPS Free Parking Pass on the dashboard of their vehicle. [Parking Pass Link](#) *Note some games will have alternate parking. The home AD and SPS Community Relations will share which games those are. Failure to display the parking pass may result in a parking fine. Free parking is available for Spokane Public Schools events only and on a first come, first served basis, with the pass readily displayed. Pass is only valid one hour before and after SPS events. Passes are also available at the ticket windows.

TEAM BUSES: Coordinate with the home school AD prior to the game. The bus parking varies based on the Arena events: options are Arena Service Lot to the southwest of the Arena, the main arena lots A & B, possibility of remaining on Joe Albi Way, or staging at North Central High School. The home school AD will let you know based on the week's events at the Arena. Buses for Soccer Season can stage on Joe Albi Way.

TICKETS & SEATING: GSL Season Pass holders receive free admission at Spokane Public School regular season games. Students will have a sticker on their ASB card if they have purchased a GSL Pass. Single game tickets may be purchased at TicketsWest.com or the stadium ticket office, located at the NW entrance (cash and credit card are accepted for tickets). NOTE: GSL/ASB passes are not accepted for Post Season. Ticketing will be available at the ticket window at ONE and also online via the ONE Spokane Stadium [website](#). *All tickets purchased online and at the window has a 10% processing fee assessed. Please provide Pass List to Home AD prior to the game.

ENTRANCES: Main ticketing gate is located at the NW Entrance. Pass lists are also located there for anyone not entering with the team. The SW entrance (on Joe Albi Way) is where team personnel will enter. Pass lists at the SW entrance are only for the current games being played. All other people on pass list need to enter at the main ticketing (NW) window.

FIELD ACCESS: Only Coaches, players, team personnel, cheerleaders, band members and media are allowed access to the field. No parents or unauthorized students are allowed on the field.

LOCKER ROOM & OFFICIALS: Both Locker Rooms and Officials Rooms are located under the home side, with entry at the SW entrance on Joe Albi Way. Showers may be available depending on stadium availability. Other nearby SPS locations are also available for team access to showers and changing spaces if needed. Coordinate with Home AD.

TRAINING ROOM: Next to Locker Rooms under home side. Enter from Joe Albi Way. Ice and water are available. AEDs located throughout the building- teams are encouraged to bring portable AEDs when available.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions are cashless, with options for grab-and-go and traditional offerings depending on the size of the event. ONE Spokane Stadium also sells \$5 cash vouchers, at the stadium's ticket office.. Cash vouchers can be used at any ONE Spokane Stadium concession stand.

PRESSBOX: Located on the west/home side on the 4th level. Access to the pressbox is via outside/inside stairs or under the stands via elevator. Home coaches will be on the south side of the pressbox, visitors on the north side. There is roof access for filming. Media boxes are also available on the south side of the pressbox. Wireless connection also available in pressbox on gameday.

PRESS: Any press accessing ONE Spokane Stadium will need to have a GSL Press Pass (can be requested via Home AD/SPS Athletics) and/or be on the Pass List at the main ticket window.

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

Clear Bag Policy: Guests may carry one clear plastic or vinyl bag no larger than 14" x 14" x 6". Small clutch bags no larger than 6.5" x 4.5" (does not have to be clear) or clear one gallon zip-top storage bags are also permitted. Backpacks and purses larger than 6.5" x 4.5" will not be permitted. Exceptions will be made for medically necessary items or single compartment diaper bags (child must be present).

Security Procedures: All guests will be required to enter through walk-through metal detectors. Please leave ALL weapons at home; including firearms, knives, and/or wallet chains.

No Outside Food or Drink: No outside food or drink allowed. Participating athletes may bring in bottled water, but this is the only exemption.

No Smoking or Vaping: ONE Spokane Stadium complies with the Washington Indoor Clean Air Act which prohibits smoking or vaping in all public places as well as 25 feet from any entrance, exit, or ventilation intake at a public place.

Pets: No pets/animals will be allowed in the stadium or in the surrounding areas, except for service animals with appropriate documentation.
