

Henderson Scholarship - \$500
John R. Rogers High School

Scholarship Specifications

Goal: The goal of the Henderson Scholarship is to provide the awarded student funding to support tuition and/or related school fees as they pursue post-secondary education/training.

Who: The scholarship will be awarded to a current Rogers HS student who would like to pursue higher education and/or training after graduation from Rogers. Eligible applicants can be interested in pursuing any field of study. Funds can be used for all types of post-secondary training including vocational schools, community college, professional career schools, and four-year collegiate institutions. The student should reflect the values of commitment to scholastic advancement and community service.

Eligibility:

- Choice of post-secondary institution can be any institution as described above but continuing to higher education is required.
- 2.5 GPA

Award Cycle: The Henderson Scholarship will be awarded on an annual basis in the Spring.

Amount: One annual award of \$500.

Scholarship Fund Specifications: The funds can be used for any school related expense including, but not limited to, tuition, school supplies, textbooks, room and board.

Application Process:

Students interested in the scholarship will submit an essay to the scholarship committee addressing the following:

- What is your current educational goal and how did your education at Rogers High School prepare you for it?
- What type of training or education do you plan to pursue after you graduate from high school to pursue your vocation?
- How do you plan to use the scholarship funds?

Reporting:

Scholarship recipients will be asked to share a brief note of what your goals are for the future, where you plan to attend college and how the scholarship funds were used.

Application Deadline: April 26, 2024 to room N106 – College and Career Center

Scholarship recipients will be notified of selection by May 20. Funds to be sent directly to recipient's school/college/university accepted for post-secondary education.
