

If student exhibits symptoms of COVID-19 while at school

- 1** School contacts parent/guardian
- 2** Student is isolated, PPE used, areas of possible exposure are disinfected.
- 3** Provide advice for student to be tested
- 4** If not tested, then exclude until 24 hours have elapsed with no fever AND 10 days have passed from symptom onset and student has symptom improvement.
- 5** May return to school prior to 10 day period with a note from healthcare provider stating different diagnosis and approval to return to school.

***Any tested student, staff or visitor should isolate while awaiting test results**



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Positive confirmation of COVID-19 in a visitor, student, or employee

- 1** The contact tracing team conducts a case investigation and requires student/employee with confirmed positive COVID-19 to isolate for 10 days during infectious period according to the Spokane Regional Health District (SRHD) guidelines.
- 2** The contact tracing team compiles a list of close contacts within the district and follows protocols set by the SRHD. Close contact is defined as being within 6 feet of another person for greater than 15 minutes
- 3** The contact tracing team notifies close contacts of potential COVID-19 exposure. Those confirmed as having had close contact are informed of 14 day quarantine requirement. Close contacts are encouraged to get tested for COVID-19. A negative test result within the 14-day quarantine does not shorten the length of quarantine.

A student, employee, or visitor is tested for COVID-19 with a **NEGATIVE** result

1 School District notifies SRHD that a students or employees are being tested for COVID-19. The individual isolates while awaiting results.

IF:

Individual has no symptoms but has had close contact with confirmed case

- ➔ Quarantine for 14 days from date of last exposure
- ➔ In households with one or more positive COVID-19 cases, the quarantine period lasts for 24 days from most recent positive test or symptom onset of any person in the home.

Individual has no current symptoms and no close contact

- ➔ May return to school if 24 hours has elapsed with no fever

Individual is symptomatic but has no close contact

- ➔ Must stay in isolation until 24 hours elapsed with no fever and symptom improvement.

Individual is symptomatic and has close contact with confirmed case

- ➔ Quarantine for 14 days from date of last exposure. May return to work if fever-free for 24 hours without use of fever-reducing medication AND have symptom improvement.
