ACCEPTANCE OF LAPTOP COMPUTER DEVICE AGREEMENT**

Parent/Guardian Consent

Parents/guardians who allow their students to participate in the Laptop Refurbishment program for Spokane School District ("District") and Spokane Public Library will receive a laptop computer device ("laptop" or "device") to be used for academic purposes. The District utilizes a network filter on the wireless internet used in District buildings. **However, the laptop may be able to connect to an outside wireless network for which there is not a network filter or for which access can be made to inappropriate or dangerous content or persons that are not blocked by the device. The District will not monitor the use of the laptop on these outside networks.** The student is expected to comply with the District policy and procedure 6400 regarding appropriate use of District computers and internet at all times while using the device. If the device is stolen or lost, a report must be made immediately to the Spokane Public Library branch from which the computer was checked out.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND AGREEMENT TO MONITOR STUDENT USE OF THE DEVICE

My child and I are aware that there are inherent risks in providing children with electronic devices. The device that is being provided to my child may be used on an outside network to access inappropriate or illegal content. Use of the device by my child to access obscene, graphic, or illegal content or to contact third parties may cause my child substantial physical and/or emotional harm.

By allowing my child to use the device, I acknowledge that I have discussed the inherent dangers in using the device, including but not limited to the dangers below. I further acknowledge that the District will not monitor my child's use of the device on an outside network. By allowing my child to use the device, I agree that my child, other members of my family, and myself have made a family decision that the student is of sufficient age and maturity to use the device in an appropriate manner.

I also agree that it is my sole responsibility to monitor my child's use of the device, and hereby agree to regularly monitor the use of the device in order to ensure that it is only used for appropriate and academic uses.

INHERENT RISKS IN THE USE OF THE DEVICE AND HARM THAT MAY RESULT

My participation in the Laptop Refurbishment program is voluntary and I knowingly assume all the risks to my child or myself that are associated with the use of the device, whether known or unknown. My child and I agree to hold the school district, its employees, agents, representatives, and volunteers harmless from any and all liability, actions, causes of action, debts, expenses, claims or demands of every kind and nature whatsoever which may arise from such dangers and risks.

AGREEMENT TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS

If any civil claim is made or filed, or if any proceeding is instituted in a federal or state court, at any time, on any matter relating to any harm related to my child's or any other person's use of the device, I hereby agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the District from and against any claims, including reasonable attorneys' fees resulting from such claims or proceedings filed by my child, myself, my other family members, or any other third parties for any or all actions against the District, or its officers, employees, or agents.
