Internet Access: The 1Million Project is focused on providing internet access to students with a lack of home internet access. A lack of home internet access means: a.) no internet access in the home, b.) multiple students in the household sharing a single computer or other device capable of performing schoolwork, or c.) dial up internet at home.

Device: Students participating in the 1Million Project will receive a device along with access to the internet for academic purposes. Sprint utilizes a network filter for all data that is transmitted through the Sprint network. Spokane School District ("District") also utilizes a network filter on the wireless internet used in District buildings. **However, the device may be able to connect to an outside wireless network for which there is not a network filter. The District will not monitor the use of the device on these outside networks.** The student is expected to comply with the school's Device Management Policy at all times while using the device. If the device is stolen or lost, a report must be made immediately to the student's school office.

Student Photograph: The 1Million Project may use the student's photograph publically to promote the Project. These images may be used in print publications, online publications, presentations, websites, and social media, but will not contain any identifying information such as student name or location. No royalty, fee or other compensation will become payable to any third party by reason of such use.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND AGREEMENT TO MONITOR STUDENT USE OF THE DEVICE

I and my student are aware that there are inherent risks in providing children with electronic devices. The device that is being provided to my student may be used on an outside network to access inappropriate or illegal content. By allowing my student to use the device, I acknowledge that I have discussed the inherent dangers in using the device, including but not limited to the dangers below. I further acknowledge that the District will not monitor the student's use of the device on an outside network.

By allowing my student to use the device, I agree that myself, my student, and other members of my family have made a family decision that the student is of sufficient age and maturity to use the device in an appropriate manner.

I also agree that it is my sole responsibility to monitor the student's use of the device, and hereby agree to regularly monitor the use of the device in order to ensure that it is only used for appropriate and academic uses.

Inherent Risks in the use of the Device and Harm that may Result

The harm that may happen to my student includes, but is not limited to the types of harm listed below. By checking the boxes below, I acknowledge that I understand and appreciate the risks associated with allowing my student to use the device. I acknowledge that my participation in the Sprint 1Million Program is voluntary and that I knowingly assume all the risks to the student or myself that are associated with the use of the device, whether known or unknown. I and my student agree to hold Sprint and the school district, its employees, agents, representatives, and volunteers harmless from any and all liability, actions, causes of action, debts, expenses, claims or demands of every kind and nature whatsoever ("claims") which may arise from such dangers and risks.

- The device may be used by the student to access graphic or obscene content. Accessing graphic or obscene content may cause my student lasting and substantial emotional harm.
- The device may be used by the student to send, receive, or download illegal content, including but not limited to illegally-downloaded media content. The use of the device to send, receive, or download illegal content may result in criminal charges, punishment, and/or fines against my student and myself. The criminal charges, punishment, and/or fines may also cause substantial harm to my student and/or myself.

- The device may be used by the student to participate in, facilitate, or become a victim of criminal activity. The use of the device to participate in or facilitate criminal activity may result in criminal charges, punishment, and/or fines. The criminal charges, punishment, and/or fines may also cause substantial harm to my student and/or myself. Becoming a victim of criminal activity may also cause substantial harm to my student and/or myself.
- The student may engage in communication with third parties, including strangers or other persons who may wish to harm myself, my child, or other family members. Communication with third parties may also result in my child sending or receiving graphic, obscene, or illegal content, or my student being subjected to bullying or other threatening behaviors. The harm caused by these third parties may cause physical and emotional harm to my student and myself or other family members.
- The student may utilize the device to arrange a meeting with a third party or stranger. Third parties may be able to otherwise track my student's location. The third parties may then use this information to cause physical or emotional harm to my student, myself, or other family members.
- Potential harm caused by this device could interfere with my student's emotional growth and ability to develop and maintain normal human relationships.
- The student may use the device to access unregulated material on the internet (i.e. the "darknet".) Use of the darknet may expose my student to access obscene, graphic, or illegal content that is far more severe than the obscene, graphic, or illegal content that is present on the regulated internet. The physical and emotional harm that may be caused by my student accessing the darknet is substantially greater than the student than would likely occur on the regulated internet.
- The student may use the device while driving, which may cause a collision in their vehicle or otherwise cause physical and/or emotional damage to others through a collision. The results of this collision may cause physical and/or emotional harm to my student.
- The student may use the device to commit a civil violation, or other negligent act that may harm a third party (for example, by committing libel or slander.) This act may create allegations of monetary or other liability for both myself and my student. This potential civil liability may cause my student, myself, and other members of my family emotional harm.
- The student may use the device to either intentionally or unintentionally send, receive, or forward material that contains a virus. Such actions may create civil liability for myself, my student, or other members of my family. This potential civil liability may cause my student, myself, and other members of my family emotional harm.
- I understand that the harms listed above are not limited to my student. Any individual who uses the device, including other children, myself, or other family members may be subject to emotional and/or physical harm through the use of the device.
- I acknowledge that this list of potential harms is not exhaustive, and that there are other foreseeable harms that may cause physical or emotional harm to myself, my student, or other members of my family.

AGREEMENT TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS

If any civil claim is made or filed, or if any proceeding is instituted in a federal or state court, at any time, on any matter relating to any harm related to the student's or any other person's use of the device, I hereby agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the District and Sprint from and against any claims, including reasonable attorneys' fees resulting from such claims or proceedings filed by my student, myself, my other family members, or any other third parties for any or all actions Sprint, the District, or its officers, employees, or agents.

FEES FOR LOST OR STOLEN DEVICES

Additionally, a fee will be charged to replace a lost or stolen device. These replacement fees are as follows: 75 dollars for any devices lost within one year of the device being provided to the student, 50 dollars for a device lost in the second year, and 25 dollars for a device lost in the third year. If these fees are not paid in a timely manner, the balance of the fee may be sent to collections.
