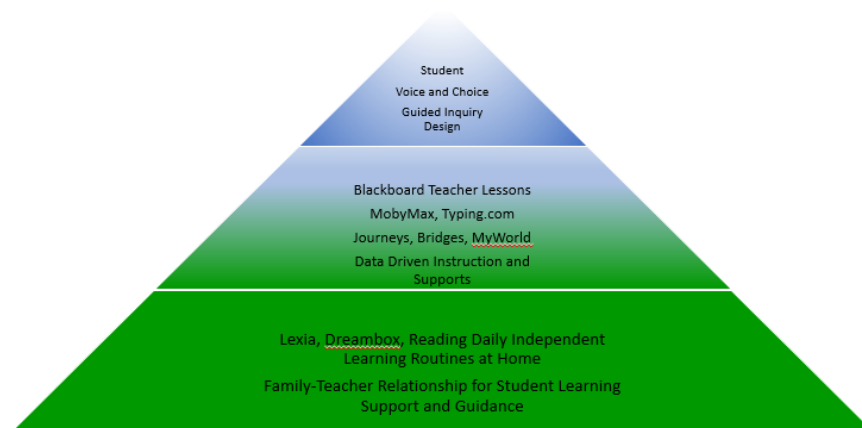
Routines in the Home for learning and exploration
