The **Alternative Parent Participation Learning Experience** (APPLE) program is a lottery choice program open to all children in grades K-5 who live within Spokane Public Schools' boundaries. Families commit to volunteer 90 hours per year (approximately 2.5 hrs. per week) in a variety of ways. Some examples include:

- Working in the classroom with individual students and small groups
- Preparing materials and supplies to support classroom learning
- Chaperoning APPLE-initiated field trips
- Serving on an academic enrichment-driven committee
- Assisting with the Garfield NET

APPLE families become part of a dynamic, caring community sharing a common goal of enriched learning for children through parent involvement.

Please note that if you've entered the lottery or elect to enter the lottery, attending the Garfield or Franklin Information Night is a requirement for acceptance into the APPLE program.
