

PROGRAM INFORMATION NIGHT

The Alternative Parent Participation Learning Experience (APPLE) program is a lottery choice program open to all children in grades K-5 who live within Spokane Public Schools' boundaries. Families commit to <u>90 volunteer hours per year</u> as part of enrollment in APPLE.

APPLE families become part of a dynamic, caring community sharing a common goal of enriched learning for children through parent and family involvement. 90 volunteer hours can be met in multiple ways, including in-school, at-home and after hour opportunities.

Attending an APPLE information session is a requirement for acceptance into the program. While the programs are similar, attending information night sessions offer school tours with school admin and teachers available for Q & A. It is highly recommended families attend the school session of your choice.
