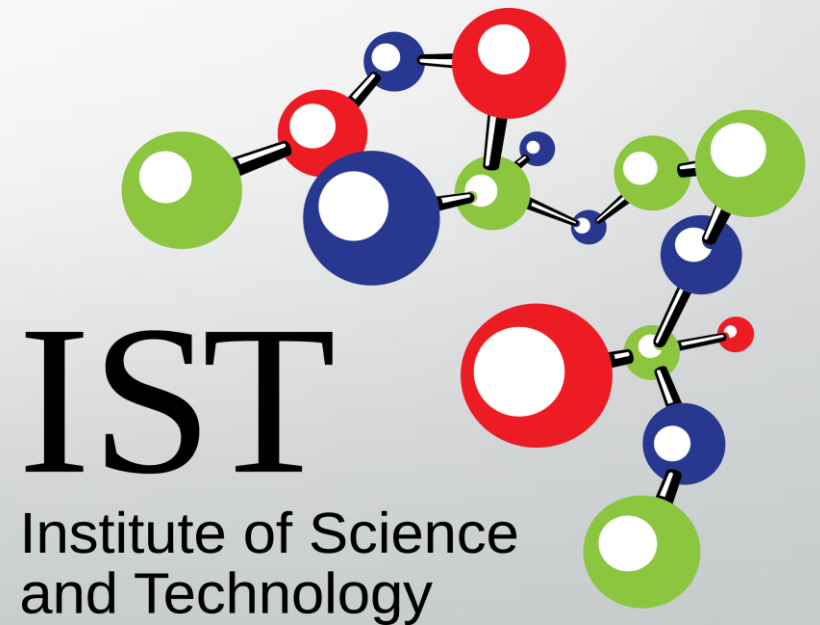

Lunch & Lockers

Lunch

- Eat 1st Lunch at approximately 11:00

Lockers

Phones & Belongings

- Phones can be used as assistive technology in the classroom!
- Some teachers will have students check them in at the start of every class.

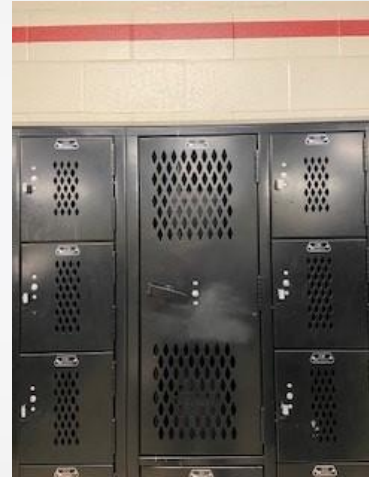
