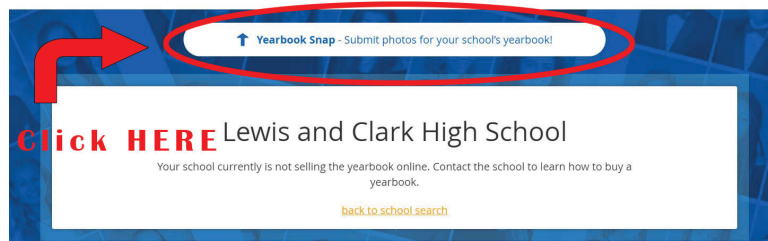

TUTORIAL

Requirements:

1. Vertical Photograph of said senior, cropped waist up. No pets, friends, or family members.
 2. Quality Image. Minimum size of 1MB, but up to 25MB.
- Note: screen shots, or social media images are too small for print.

Please note the following:

- Photos should be vertical in orientation and waist up, horizontal photos do not fit our photo frames and will be cropped or rejected. Full body shots will be cropped to waist up.
- If submission doesn't meet requirements above, the photo will be cropped to fit. Facial obstructions including masks are not permitted in senior photos.
- Any photos that violate school policy or are overtly distracting will be rejected. Example: drugs, alcohol, weapons, etc.
- Questionable photos will be reviewed by a yearbook committee (Advisor, Editor, Student, Administrator) and rejected if not found to be in good taste or appropriate for the senior section.
