









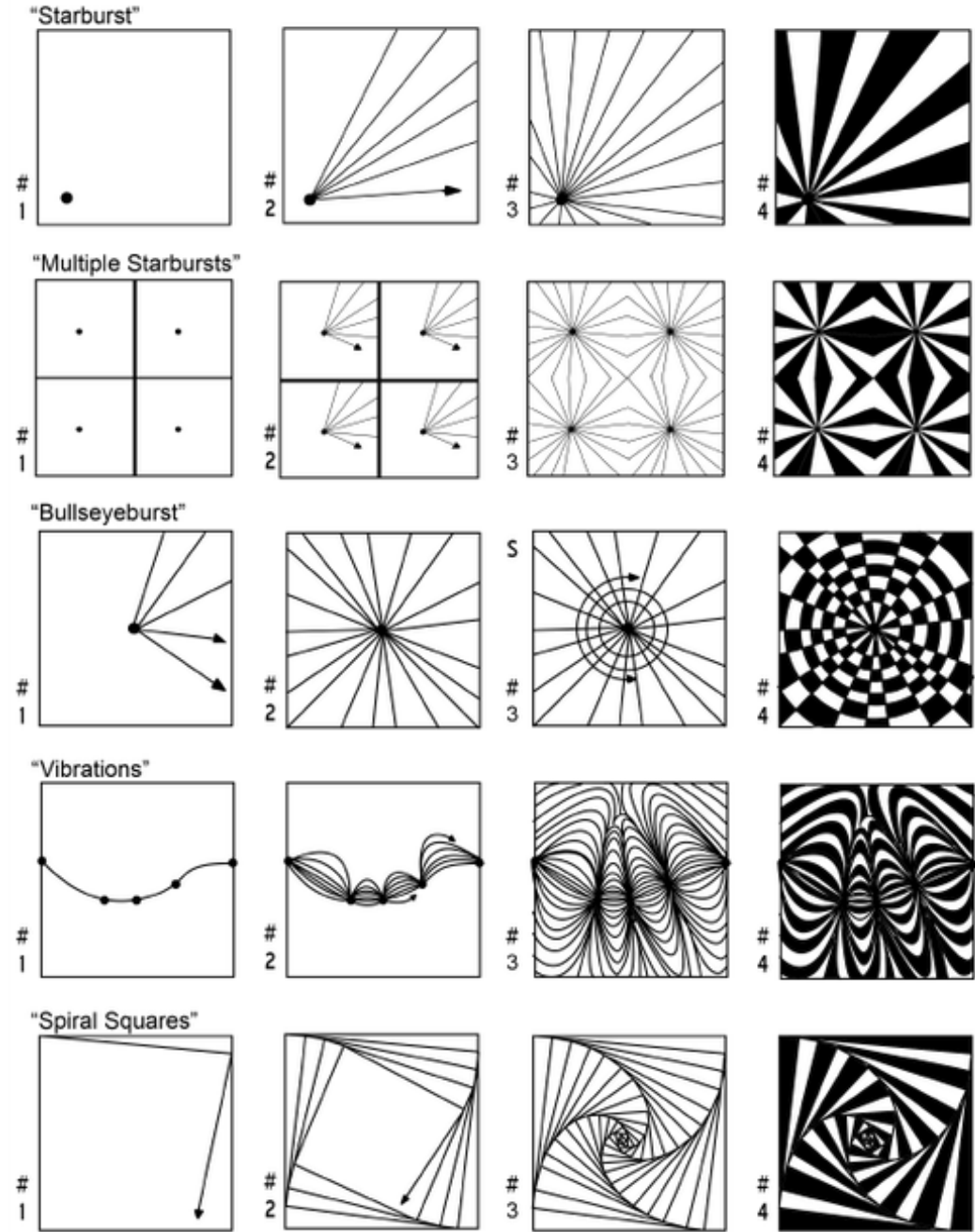

- Draw the candy with the wrapper and capture all the details.

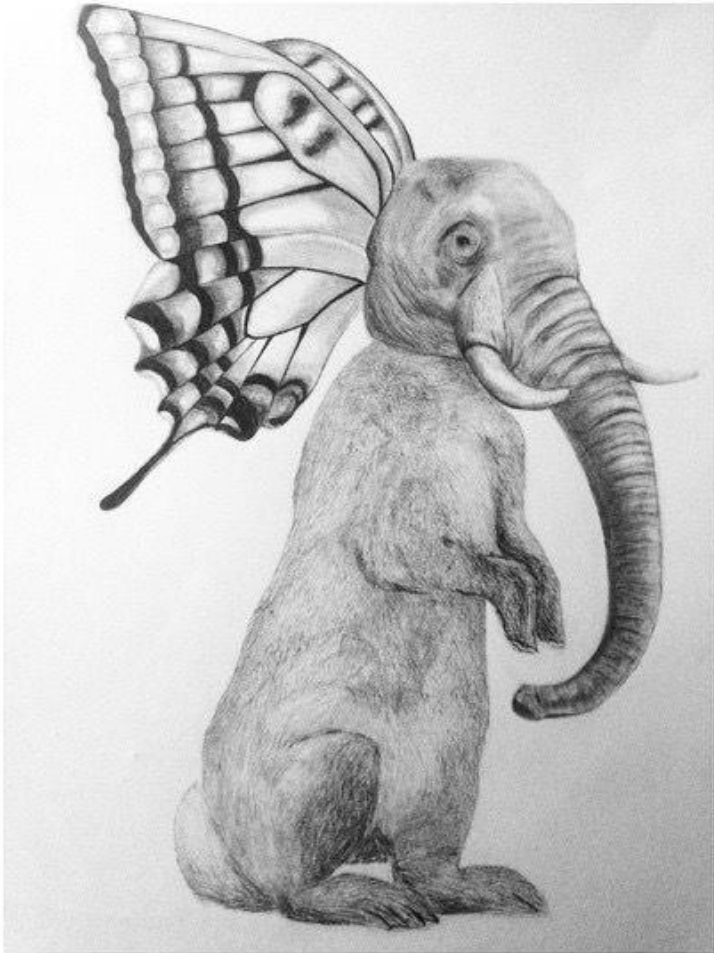


# Go outside and find natural objects

# 3 in 1 animal



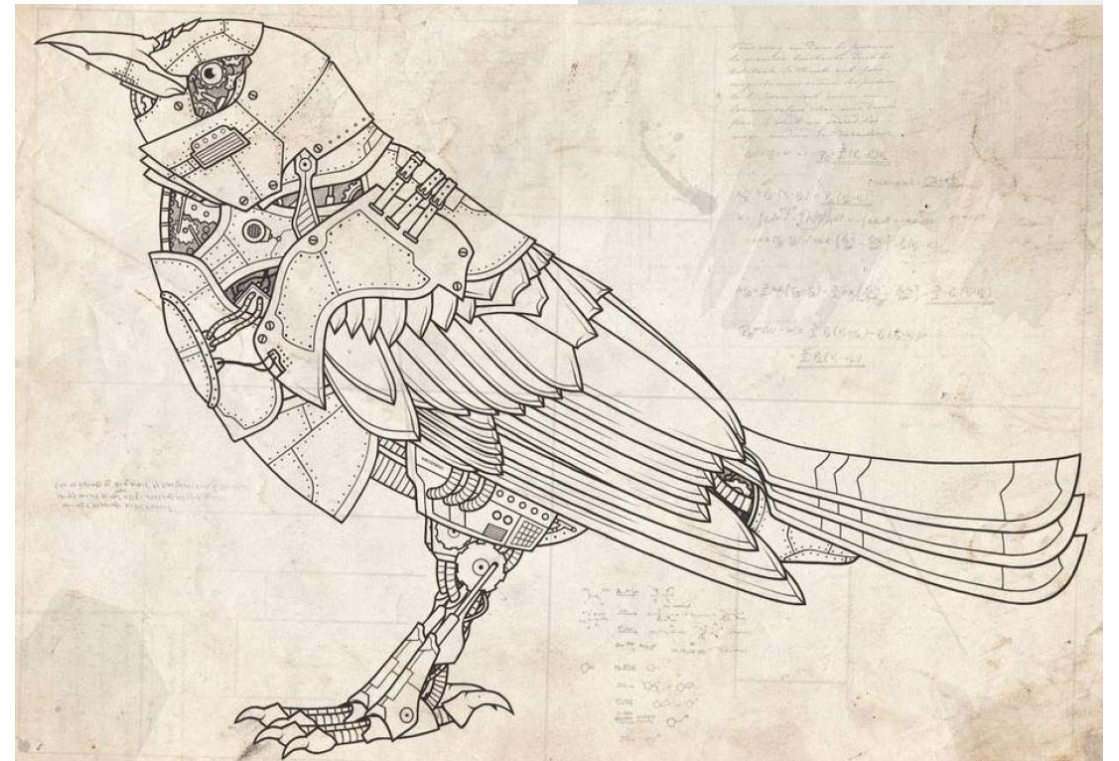
- Search up different animals and create a drawing mixing 3 animals in 1 drawing.

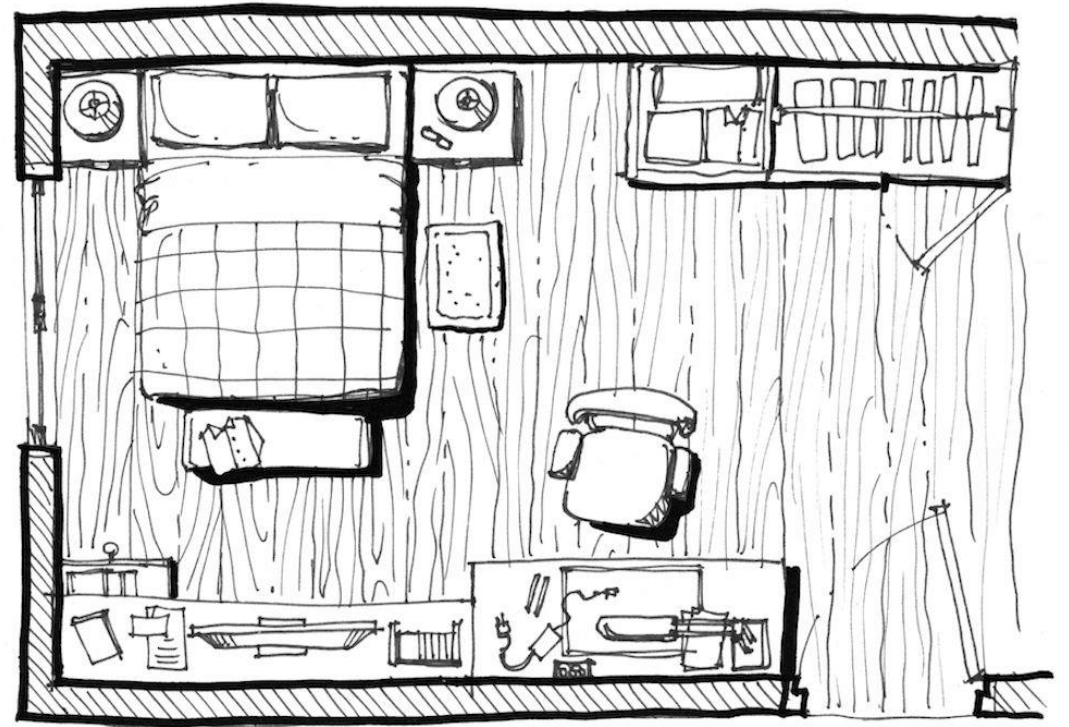

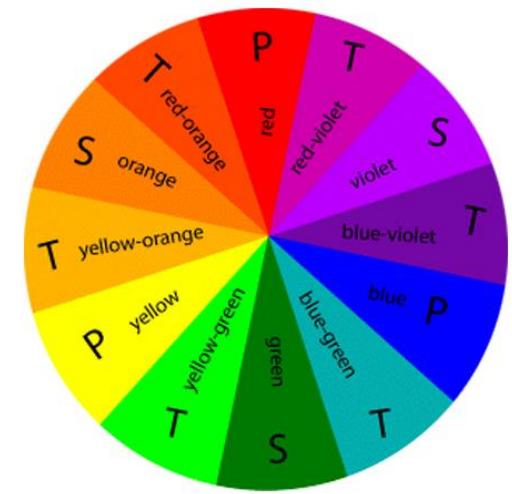
# Draw the floor plan of your room
