Help School Funding Get Added Benefits:

Although Washington state
has made it possible to
continue serving free lunch and
breakfast to all of our district
students through a program
called Community Eligibility
Provision (CEP), this changes
the information we need from
families to continue supporting
school funding.

What do you have to do?
We need a Family Income Survey
(FIS) from all of our families.

This is similar to a free and reduced lunch application. The form can be filled out online at spokaneschools.org/CEP Students who qualify can get added benefits like Pandemic EBT, reduced medical fees, waived sports and academic testing fees, reduced fees in our community including reduced veterinary fees and internet fees.

When do we have to do it?
We need this information at the start of the school year. You will have the opportunity to fill out the Family Income Survey at your schools open house and beginning of the year teacher conferences. Please have it completed by September 26th.

Thank you for your help to maintain school program funding.

Food Substitutions (and Allergies)

Food substitutions can be made if there is a medical reason for the request:

- For non-life threatening issues, use the Digestive Disorder form.
- For life-threatening allergy food substitution requests, use the Allergy Plan order form.

Making Deposits:

To help keep students and staff safe and provide efficient meal service, no cash will be accepted in meal serving lines. Deposit money at your school office or go to Online Meal Payments at spokaneschools.org.

Online Deposits and Student Accounts:

- Deposit money for the Ala Carte items into your student's meal account quickly and easily at myschoolbucks.com.
- View your child's meal account history and get low balance reminders even if you do not make a deposit online.

Deposit at Your School Office:

Checks: Please make checks out to your child's school with the **child's full** name on the memo line. The entire amount of the check will be deposited in the child's account; we are unable to give change. If checks are returned twice due to non-sufficient funds, future purchases will be on a cash basis only.

Meal Charges: Students can get ONE free breakfast and lunch each school day. Second meals, entrees, and ala carte items can be purchased if the student has cash in their student account. No charges are allowed for the purchase of second meals, entrees, and ala carte items.

If a student's meal account has an existing negative balance, that balance can be paid at your school office or at myschoolbucks.com.
