Dr. Anderson opened the meeting with a reminder of the committee's task to develop boundary adjustments to present to the School Board for approval by next spring. The district team is working simultaneously to support the School Board in finalizing a policy that provides timeframes for students to remain in their current schools after school boundaries are changed (legacy policy) and anticipates that this work will be completed in the spring as well.

The focus of the meeting was on the same map as the prior meeting. Committee members were asked to consider boundary adjustments that would balance school enrollments against capacities as well as free and reduced lunch status. The committee used an interactive Excel spreadsheet to analyze data from several scenarios to see the effect on enrollment and free and reduced status of each school as various neighborhood assignment options were selected. The committee broke into small groups to analyze the data from each scenario and reported back with thoughts and/or recommendations to the larger group.

After all of the groups had reported out on their analysis and recommendations for the various scenarios, the facilitator noted that there were similarities across the groups and the district team would use those to help the committee progress into other areas of the district map at the next meeting.
