- **Past PFAs**

- Students are encouraged to continue being self-directed learners. Students should be using the playlists and resources in Summit to take notes, study, and understand key vocabulary and concepts for the assessment.
- Students need to fill out a **Request to Test form** (Google form to replace our paper version of the test ticket). These forms are located in your Teams class. Look in the files section. English test tickets are to be filled out in English team. Math test tickets are to be filled out in math team. Science test tickets are to be filled out in science team. Social studies test tickets are to be filled out in social studies team. **Teachers only have access to their content request forms.**
- Students may then request to take the assessment in Summit.
- We will approve assessments on Tuesdays and Thursdays between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. AND after the test ticket has been submitted. ****These days, times and expectations are subject to change as we transition to the district's remote learning plan.****

- **Past Projects**

- Additionally, students may work on any overdue projects in Summit that are yellow or red. Check the final product directions, rubrics, and learning that was covered in checkpoints to see what you did not complete and focus on finishing those.

- **Monday**

- Beginning next week, I will post a reading assignment on MS Teams. Students will be able to access a link to the reading assignment if they do not have the hard copy (book/play) with them.
- Students will need to have the assigned reading completed prior to our Live session on Wednesday.

- **Wednesday**

- We will discuss the assigned reading in our Live session. Seventh grade is scheduled at 1:45 and 8th grade is scheduled at 12:45. This is a good time for students to share their thinking about the reading, ask questions, and clarify their understanding of the content. I will post a quiz after our Live. This will help the student to determine their level of understanding of the content and whether or not they need to seek additional support to understand ideas and concepts of assigned reading.

- I will post an assignment, assessment, or reflection for the student to complete in Teams. This work will be used to help prepare the student for the final project for the unit we are currently working on in Summit.
