➤ Past PFAs

- Students should continue being self-directed learners. Remember to be utilizing the playlists resources in Summit to take notes, study, and understand key terms and concepts for the content assessments.
 - **8th Grade:** Approximately 25 students still need to take and pass Types of Forces, while most need to take and pass Conservation of Energy (follow PFA guidelines below)
 - **8th Grade:** A Conservation of Energy PRE-Quiz is posted under assignments in the TEAMS page. That is due prior to our Tuesday meeting at 2pm. If you miss the "due date", take it anyway. If you have already passed the Conservation of Energy PFA, take it anyway and see if you get 100%! Here's the [link](#):
 - **7th Grade:** A few students still need to take and pass Natural Selection, while quite a few more students need to finish notes for and pass Adaptation and History of Life.  - **7th Grade:** A Photosynthesis/Cellular Respiration PRE-Quiz is posted under assignments in the TEAMS page. That is due prior to our Tuesday meeting at 1pm. - Remember the **new protocol for taking a Content assessment**: Students need to fill out a Request to Test form (Google form to replace our paper version of the test ticket). These forms are located in your Teams class. Look in the files section. Science test tickets are to be filled out from the SCIENCE Team's page. Teachers only have access to their content request forms. Students may then request to take the assessment in Summit.
- We will approve assessments on Tuesdays and Thursdays between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. ONLY after the test ticket has been submitted. **These days, times and expectations are subject to change as we transition to the district's remote learning plan.**

➤ Projects:

- 8th Grade: Finish "Problem with Plastics" project if it's not done yet. It is past due. Make sure you look through the rubric AND the requirements that are posted in the FILES of the 8th Grade Team page. You must be using the work that you did in your Checkpoints to complete your project. Follow directions and please check the list of requirements posted under "Files" on the 8th Grade Science Teams Page.
- 7th Grade: Finish "Evoworld" project if it is not completed yet. It is past due. Make sure you look through the rubric AND open the "Sample" under "resources for Everyone" on the overview page of Evoworld. You should be using the work that you did in your Checkpoints to complete your project.

- Done with your PFA's and Project? Remember that students may work on any overdue projects in Summit that are yellow or red. Check the final product directions, rubrics, and learning that was covered in checkpoints to see what you did not complete and focus on finishing those.
