Should Schools Eliminate Sports Teams?

Sports are a huge part of the American school experience. Last year, almost 8 million high school students participated in organized athletics.

But some schools are considering cutting back or even eliminating their sports programs. One reason is increasingly tight school budgets. Team sports can be a major expense for a school, especially sports that require a lot of equipment, like football. Another factor is the nationwide push to raise academic standards. The more time and attention faculty and students give to classwork, the less there is for extra-curricular activities. Safety concerns—such as injuries to student athletes—are also leading some schools to take a closer look at their sports programs.

Yet enthusiasm for athletics is strong and growing. According to the National Federation of State High School Associations, participation in school sports has increased by about 34 percent over the past 20 years. Experts point to the important role that physical activity plays in kids' ability to focus in school as well as in their overall health and well-being—including boosting their self-confidence.
