Learning goals for this week include:

1. Take what we know about solving equations and apply that to solving inequalities (what is the one difference??)
2. Know how to graph a solution to an inequality and how to write an inequality solution to match a graph.
3. Feel confident in our ability to use Teams and Khan Academy to complete our distance learning requirements.

Expectations:

1. Students will login to Teams at least once a week to check in with Mrs. Burns and to get the weekly learning plans.
2. Students will complete work on Khan Academy, using the assigned videos and practice problems to solidify their understanding of the material.
