

Overview

These courses will strengthen your reading and writing skills. We will read a variety of literature sources including those from multiple genres. In our class students will assume the role of literary scholars and critical thinkers. As such, the ability to comprehend and summarize is expected. We will work to develop the ability to analyze and **think critically about literature**. Students will become knowledgeable on using the **text as evidence** to support an argument. We will also study how authors use **literary devices, elements, and word choice** to enhance their literature. The core of these tasks will always be in strengthening your reading and writing skills.

- ✓ I can analyze the author's choices regarding the development of characters, ideas or themes, the setting, as well as the structure of the text.

- ✓ I can analyze literary devices as well as word choice in order to better understand a text.
- ✓ I can determine the meaning of words using context clues and roots, prefixes, and suffixes.
- ✓ I can use English grammar and conventions appropriately and correctly.
- ✓ Apply the writing process through planning, drafting, revising, and editing.
- ✓ I can write an effective argumentative essay.

Beginning of class → Take a seat, put your phone/headphones away, submit any homework assignments, complete your entry task, and wait for further instruction.


During class → Be an active participant in your learning. Listen, collaborate, and ask questions.
