INSTRUCTIONAL GOALS

Students will learn and practice Pro-Social and Academic skills in the learning environment through personal interactions with peers and adults. Topics that will be covered are; Anger Management, Coping Skills, Problem Solving, Time Management, Decision Making and Managing Stress. Students will learn these skills through interactive activities, discussion, one-on-one processing, writing assignments, surveys, self-directed assessments and personal journaling.

At the end of this course, students will:

- *Identify triggers, which negatively affect behavior
- *Understand that there are consequences and rewards for all behaviors positive or negative.
- *Apply appropriate Pro-Social and Academic strategies in the classroom and social situations.

MATERIALS

To successfully complete this course, you must be prepared with basic school supplies; paper, pencils and notebook. In the event that these items cannot be obtained, our program will provide them as needed as well.
