WHAT this course is about:

Use hiragana, katakana, and kanji in writing. We also deepen our understanding of culture.

Japanese 3 is a college level curriculum. Students deepen their understanding of Japanese language and culture. More kanji are introduced, including some of the AP kanji required for the test. Japanese history, Japanese manners/etiquette are introduced through Japanese cultural videos, movies, or shows. By the end of year 3, the students will be able to have a conversation about making new friends, plan a small trip, describe their experiences, organize a birthday party, and plan a vacation with friends. Students will begin exchanging letters with Japanese college students from Mukogawa Fort Wright Institute to develop their communication skills.
