WHAT this course is about:

The goal of this course is to develop fundamental skills and an understanding of painting techniques. The history of painting and the social impact, both in history and contemporary life, are discussed as part of visual art in context. Students will demonstrate competency by understanding and executing the following techniques and methods: A La Prima, Glazing, Texture, Color, Value, and Composition. Students will paint from life and found visual source materials and will begin to build a personal body of work that can form a portfolio for college admission. Students will learn the process of critiquing artwork and will learn how to look and appreciate the process of painting. This is a very fun class, allowing students to be expressive with various paint mediums including oils, acrylic, gouache, and watercolor.
