Are there any prerequisites for the course?

Students must be a sophomore, junior, or senior. This is a 0 hour class and students must provide their own transportation. Students who register for this course will receive an application to fill out. Applications and previous Tiger Drama experience in shows and working on crews are taken into consideration.

WHAT this course is about:

Stagecraft is a hands-on class in which participants actively explore and create elements for the many technical areas of theater including lighting, sound, makeup, set design, costumes, publicity, and stage management. Outside class work on a crew for Tiger Drama productions and school concerts is a class expectation.

WHY take this course:

We would love to have you as a member of our Tiger Drama family. Working together to create class work and/or on one of our productions is a great way to meet new people and eventually take on a leadership role. You also have opportunities to travel to local, regional, state, and national theatre festivals and competitions. This class satisfies a CTE requirement.

WHAT you'll learn:

Stagecraft students will further enhance and utilize skills through intensive and specialized class work designing, building, and producing our mainstage performances. Class work will include instruction in design and construction of our productions as well as fundamental skills in lighting, sound, costumes, hair and makeup, and front of house duties. This class focuses on the skills needed to gain experience and work in the entertainment industry at a professional level and prepare for a collegiate theatre program.

WHAT you'll do:

Our Stagecraft students typically take on leadership roles in our afterschool productions and serve as crew leads and mentors. This is a physical class where each day you are contributing to the success of our productions by designing and building the creative elements of our shows.

WHERE this could take you:

Tiger Drama classes are designed to maximize opportunities to learn transferable life skills applicable to any plans you have after high school. You will build your confidence, problem-solving and collaborative skills alongside developing your talents. Whether you plan to pursue theatre after high school or just enjoy being part of a program during your time at LC, you will have access to festivals, special events, productions, and workshop opportunities that will help you be successful no matter where you are in experience or interest level.
