



Course Name: Musical Theatre - Advanced

Duration: 1 Semester Full Year

Are there any prerequisites for the course?

Tiger Drama advanced classes (*Advanced Theatre and Advanced Musical Theatre*) are by **AUDITION ONLY** and require completion of Beginning OR Intermediate Theatre. Auditions for placement in advanced classes are held each spring after registration is complete. If you are interested in auditioning for an advanced class, you will register for "Advanced Theatre" on your registration form. Your audition will determine your placement in *either* Advanced Theatre or Advanced Musical Theatre.

WHAT this course is about:

Advanced Musical Theatre is designed for the student already gifted with the basic abilities of acting, singing, and dancing in musical theatre performances, or the student that is seeking to improve one or more of these skills.

WHY take this course:

We would love to have you as a member of our Tiger Drama family. Working together to create class work and/or on one of our productions is a great way to meet new people and eventually take on a leadership role. You also have opportunities to travel to local, regional, state, and national theatre festivals and competitions.

WHAT you'll learn:

Advanced Musical Theatre will further enhance and utilize skills through intensive and specialized class work typically culminating with a mainstage performance. Class work will include instruction in dance, acting, vocal performance, and auditioning. This class focuses on the skills needed to gain the endurance to perform at a professional level and prepare for a collegiate theatre program.

WHAT you'll do:

As an Advanced Musical Theatre student, you will participate in group performances in both Opening Night and Closing Night showcases. You will have multiple in-class performances ranging from lip-syncs to challenge projects where you choose the area of growth you want to focus on as an actor. Advanced Musical Theatre students prepare material for the annual Thespy Festival and have the option of presenting that material for adjudication. You will develop your theatre knowledge, skills and talents building your confidence throughout the year. MT typically produces a show from class rehearsals and does require some afterschool and evening commitments for rehearsals and performances.

WHERE this could take you:

Tiger Drama classes are designed to maximize opportunities to learn transferable life skills applicable to any plans you have after high school. You will build your confidence, problem-solving and collaborative

skills alongside developing your talents. Whether you plan to pursue theatre after high school or just enjoy being part of a program during your time at LC, you will have access to festivals, special events, productions, and workshop opportunities that will help you be successful no matter where you are in experience or interest level.
