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Supplies Needed:

Ms. Niemi's Grading Policy:

I am very intentional about assigning little to no homework; however, if you choose not to use class time well or don't finish an assignment during class, then you will definitely have homework. Here are a few notes about grading:

- Participation is expected from every student from using class time wisely to asking questions. If you are on the borderline of a grade at Quarter/Semester, I will take into consideration your participation and effort in class
- Our entry task is called the "Daily Learning Opportunity" or DLO - will be worth two (2) points every day or ten (10) points per week. If you are absent, please make sure to get the DLO you missed from a classmate. DLOs are the EASIEST way to cushion your grade!
- Labs and activities are typically worth the most points in class, so make sure you take the time to complete them thoroughly
- Once a semester has ended, I will not accept any work from that semester. Everything must be turned in before the end of that grading period
