WSSDA Leadership Development:

- Washington School Board Standards: These standards are intended for use by local school
 boards and individual directors as a common framework for school board governance. Two sets
 of standards were developed to encourage school boards and individual school directors to
 subscribe to the highest levels of professional and personal conduct and performance. The
 standards encourage boards to focus on student achievement as their primary responsibility and
 provide an opportunity for clarity of board roles and responsibilities and of the expected skills,
 knowledge and behaviors of school directors.
- Board Boot Camp @ WSSDA Annual Conference (Nov 17-19, Spokane): You'll hear from trainers with school board experience as they cover the basics of board service and answer questions. You'll also connect with new board members from around the state while exploring scenarios you're likely to encounter as a school director. The superintendent panel "What your superintendent would love to tell you... but probably won't" is a favorite of many attendees. Superintendents are encouraged to attend with their board members for the best experience.
- Online Board Self-Assessment: WSSDA's online Board Self-Assessment survey is an easy-to-use
 tool that helps school boards assess and strengthen their performance in governing for
 improved student learning. Research-based and scientifically validated, the survey is based on
 the Washington School Board Standards.
