 - A high-quality college level/AP specific textbook with depth in its reading passages and numerous and representative visuals
 - Concise excerpts from appropriate primary source documents
 - Vocabulary assistance in either a complete glossary or numerous in-text definitions
 - A good quality array of corresponding teacher resources (test bank in AP format, presentations, visuals, maps, etc.)
- Online and Hardbound Print Access to the textbook and corresponding resources for students and teachers
 - Easily accessible content for teachers and students
- Ability to keep content up to date

Elements Desired But Not Required:

Chapter review questions (in online and/or print format) that match the AP format
