## STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. CHANGES OR WITHDRAWAL: All changes and erasures must be made before solicitation opening time and initialed. Respondent may not withdraw after solicitation opening time or prior to the award of contract(s). No alteration in any of the terms, conditions, delivery, quality, quantities or specifications of this solicitation will be considered without prior written consent of Spokane Public Schools Purchasing Director.

2. ADDENDA: All official clarifications or interpretations of the solicitation documents will be by written addenda. Clarification given in any other form will be informal and unofficial.

3. ACCEPTANCE/REJECTION: Spokane Public Schools reserves the right to accept or reject submittals on each item separately or as a whole, to reject any or all submittals, to waive informalities, and to contract in the best interests of Spokane Public Schools.

4. RESPONSE PRICING: Unless otherwise specified, all prices shall be for new products F.O.B. destination. Unless solicitation is designated "all or none", Respondent may quote on any or all items. Tie-ins will be considered where advantageous. Prices quoted shall include all handling and packaging costs. There is no expressed or implied obligation by Spokane Public Schools to reimburse any firm or individual for any costs

incurred in preparing or submitting bids.

5. TEST AND EVALUATION: Spokane Public Schools applies an Adoption process of test and evaluation designed to ensure essential quality depending on the intended use of various published curriculum. The curriculum has been approved by the Board of Directors, therefore all products should be considered as identified with the statement "Do Not Substitute". However, Spokane Public Schools may consider additional ISBN if the requested ISBN should be unattainable and invites Respondents to make these Alternate ISBN's available for evaluation and possible addition to future "Do Not Substitute" listings of approved ISBN. The decision by Spokane Public Schools regarding adding to future "Do Not Substitute" listings of approved ISBN shall be final.

7. DELIVERY: For any exception to the delivery date as specified on any order resulting from this solicitation, Supplier shall give prior notification and obtain written approval thereto from the appropriate Buyer with respect to delivery. Time is of the essence and an awarded order is subject to termination for failure to deliver as specified and/or appropriate damages. The acceptance by Spokane Public Schools of late performance with or without objection or reservation shall not waive the right to claim damage for such breach nor constitute a waiver of the requirements for the timely performance of any obligation remaining to be performed by Supplier. Failure to comply with delivery expectations as laid out in this document may result in the Supplier being considered as "non-responsive" to all other opportunities with Spokane Public Schools.

8. PAYMENTS, CASH DISCOUNT, and LATE PAYMENT CHARGES: Invoices will not be processed for payment, nor will the period commence for computation of cash discount until receipt of a properly completed invoice or invoiced items are received, whichever is later. If an adjustment in payment is necessary due to damage or dispute, the cash discount period shall commence on the date final approval for payment is authorized. All products are subject to inspection and acceptance by Spokane Public Schools personnel before final payment. At sole discretion of Spokane Public Schools, partial payments may be made for partial deliveries.

9. INVOICES/PACKING SLIPS: All invoices shall be delivered to the accounting department, 200 North Bernard, Spokane, WA 99201. Spokane Public Schools shall provide payment within 30 days receipt of an approved, acceptable invoice providing services/goods have been received by Spokane Public Schools. Packing list(s) shall be enclosed with each and every shipment pursuant to any purchase order issued as a result of this solicitation, indicating the content therein. Both invoices and packing slips shall indicate the awarding purchase order number as issued by Spokane Public Schools.

10. REJECTION: All goods or materials purchased herein are subject to approval by Spokane Public Schools. Any rejection of goods or material resulting because of nonconformity to the terms and specifications of this order, whether held by Spokane Public Schools or returned, will be at Supplier's risk and expense.

11. IDENTIFICATION: All invoices, packing lists, each package, shipping notices, instruction manuals, and other written documents affecting this order shall contain the applicable purchase order number.

12. INFRINGEMENTS: Supplier agrees to protect and save harmless Spokane Public Schools against all claims, suits or proceedings for patent, trademark, copyright or franchise infringement arising from the purchase, installation, or use of goods and materials ordered, and to assume all expenses and damages arising from such claims, suits or proceedings.

13. WARRANTIES: Supplier warrants that articles supplied under this order conform to specifications herein and are fit for the purpose for which such goods are ordinarily employed, except that if a particular purpose is stated, the material must then be fit for that particular purpose.

14. ASSIGNMENTS: The provisions or moneys due under this contract shall only be assignable with prior written consent of the Executive Director of Finance.

15. TAXES: Unless otherwise indicated Spokane Public Schools agrees to pay all sales or use tax in accordance with the Washington State Department of Revenue Sales Tax Rules at the time of delivery. Note that Spokane Public Schools is a political subdivision of the State of Washington and is thereby exempt from federal excise tax QUOTED PRICES SHALL NOT INCLUDE TAXES.

16. LIENS, CLAIMS AND ENCUMBRANCES: Supplier warrants and represents that all the goods and materials ordered herein are free and clear of all liens, claims, or encumbrances of any kind.

17. RISK OF LOSS: Regardless of FOB point, Supplier agrees to bear all risks of loss, injury or destruction of goods and materials ordered herein which occur prior to delivery. Such loss, injury or destruction shall not release Supplier from any obligation hereunder.

18. SAVE HARMLESS: Supplier shall protect, indemnify, and save Spokane Public Schools harmless from and against any damage, cost or liability for any injuries to persons or property arising from acts or omissions of Supplier, his employees, agents or subcontractors howsoever caused.

19. TERMINATION: In the event of a breach by Supplier of any of the provisions of this contract, Spokane Public Schools reserves the right to cancel and terminate this contract forthwith upon giving oral notice followed up in writing, or written notice to Supplier. Supplier shall be liable for damages suffered by Spokane Public Schools resulting from Supplier's breach of contract. Failure to comply with delivery expectations as laid out in this document may result in the Supplier being considered as "non-responsive" to all other opportunities with Spokane Public Schools.

20. NONDISCRIMINATION AND AFFIRMATIVE ACTION: In providing Spokane Public Schools with product and/or services, the Supplier assures compliance with Washington State and federal guidelines regarding nondiscrimination and harassment and agrees not to discriminate against or harass any client, employee or applicant for employment or services because of race, creed, color, national origin, gender, sex, marital status, age, sexual orientation including gender identity, Vietnam-era veteran or disabled veteran status, pregnancy or the presence of any sensory, mental or physical handicap with regard to, but not limited to, the following employment upgrading, demotion, or transfer, recruitment or recruitment advertising, lay-offs or termination, rates of pay or other forms of compensation, selection for training or rendition of services

21. ANTI-TRUST: Supplier and Spokane Public Schools recognize that in actual economic practice, overcharges resulting from anti-trust violations are in fact borne by Spokane Public Schools. Therefore, Supplier hereby assigns to Spokane Public Schools any and all claims for such overcharges.

22. DEFAULT: The Supplier covenants and agrees that in the event suit is instituted by Spokane Public Schools for any default on the part of the Supplier, and the Supplier is adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be in default, he shall pay to Spokane Public Schools all cost, expenses expended or incurred by Spokane Public

Schools in connection therewith, and reasonable attorney's fees. The Supplier agrees that the Superior Court of the State of Washington shall have jurisdiction over any such suit, and that venue shall be laid in Spokane County.

23. TOBACCO/DRUG/WEAPON PROHIBITION: Spokane Public Schools' property is a tobacco free, drug free, and weapon free environment. Supplier personnel shall conform to this policy at all times while on Spokane Public Schools' premises.

24. CONFLICT OF INTEREST: Spokane Public Schools' officers and employees may not accept or receive, directly or indirectly, a personal financial benefit; or accept any gift, token, membership, or service, as a result of a Spokane Public Schools' purchase entered into, or anticipated in the future, from any person, firm, or corporation. Spokane Public Schools' employees within the course of their employment are prohibited from accepting any gratuity (including food or beverages) from a supplier of goods or services to Spokane Public Schools.

25. EMPLOYMENT PROHIBITION: In accordance with Title 28A RCW: Supplier shall prohibit any employee of Supplier from working at a public school who has contact with children at the school during the course of his or her employment and who has pled guilty to or been convicted of any felony crime involving the physical neglect of a child under Chapter 9A.42 RCW, the physical injury or death of a child under Chapter 9A.32 or 9A.36 RCW (except motor vehicle violations under Chapter 46.61 RCW), sexual exploitation of a child under Chapter 9A.48 RCW, the sale or purchase of a minor child under RCW 9A.64.030, or violation of similar laws of another jurisdiction. 1. <u>AWARD</u>: <u>This solicitation will be awarded on a line by line basis</u>, and may be awarded to the responsible respondent(s), as defined in RCW 39.26.160, submitting the lowest responsive submittal after evaluation by Spokane Public Schools of the services and/or products to be supplied. The right is reserved to cancel this solicitation in part or as a whole. Successful Respondents will be notified by Spokane Public Schools via fax, email or mail following evaluation and approval.

2. <u>DISCOUNTS</u>: Discount terms will be considered in determining the low submittal. The period will commence on the date on which the correctly completed invoices are received by the school district or when the product is received, whichever is later. If an adjustment or damage occurs on a shipment subject to cash discount, the discount will be applied on the date final approval for payment is authorized. <u>However, discounts less than 1 percent or discount</u> periods less than 20 working days after receipt of items will not be considered as evaluation factors in the award of contracts.

3. <u>PRODUCT LABELING & QUALITY:</u> All products awarded as a result of this solicitation shall be delivered clearly labeled with the specified manufacturer's name and product number as indicated on the solicitation response document(s). Items received with generic, non-specific wrapping will be returned at Supplier's expense. Products received after award, which do not possess quality levels consistent with good workmanship or performance standards shall be removed and replaced at Supplier expense.
