Conference Meeting

- The default method for conferences is **in-person**, but families can request a phone or virtual option if they are unable to attend in-person. (Please contact your teacher or school directly to change the method away from in-person if necessary).
- At the conference your teacher will provide an overview of school logistics (*verifying your contact information, helping you get connected to PowerSchool [Secondary], check on laptop/internet needs, highlight the importance of regular attendance, and connect you to school and community resources*).

Helpful Hints

- Your teacher/advisor will be asking you and your student(s) questions about how school has gone in the past and what they and the school can do to help your family for the upcoming school year.
- Schools will also have a quick survey that we need completed for every family as well as a variety of information on community partners, resources, athletics/activities and other supports. Student lunches are available both days (Thurs. 9/1 and Fri. 9/2).
- ELD families will be contacted by the SPS ELD Department to provide them with translation services, either in-person or via language line translation services.
