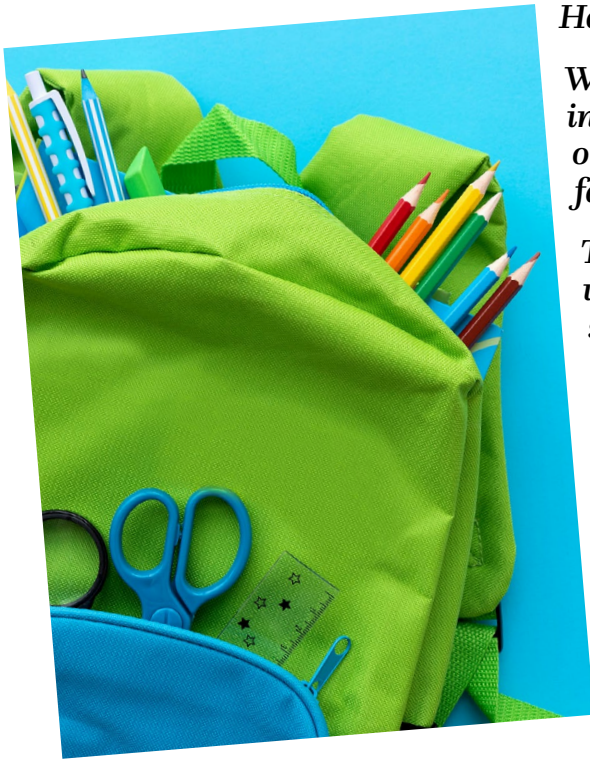


# HUSKY HAPPENINGS
