## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that a contract be awarded to M.E. Uphus Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$240,598.00 for the Madison Elementary School Kitchen Remodel Project. Total cost includes the Base Bid and Alternate No. 1 plus Unit Pricing for re-flashing existing penetrations through the roof above kitchen area 143.

### BACKGROUND

This project for the Madison Elementary School Kitchen Remodel consists of remodeling the existing kitchen and the construction of a 532 square foot addition on the east side of the kitchen. A new electrical service for the kitchen will be installed, along with new domestic water and waste piping. The existing cooler, freezer, dishwasher and booster heater, garbage disposal, and assorted shelving and work tables will be relocated from the NEWTECH Skills Center to the new kitchen addition. This provided an approximate \$100,000 in savings to the project.

There were a total of six general contractors that submitted bids for this project with pricing provided well within the budget for this project. Thus, it is recommended that a contract be awarded M.E. Uphus Construction, Inc. for the project. M. E. Uphus has worked with the district in the past on projects of similar size and scope and the Architect has reviewed the responsibility criteria recommending acceptance of the bid.

This award will be funded with 2015 bond dollars, and is scheduled to be substantially complete by August 26, 2016. In anticipation of the school being occupied by students and staff during a portion of the project, work will be limited to two (2) specific areas in the facility and special safety protocols and procedures will be in effect. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the standard 15% contingency amount for this project.
